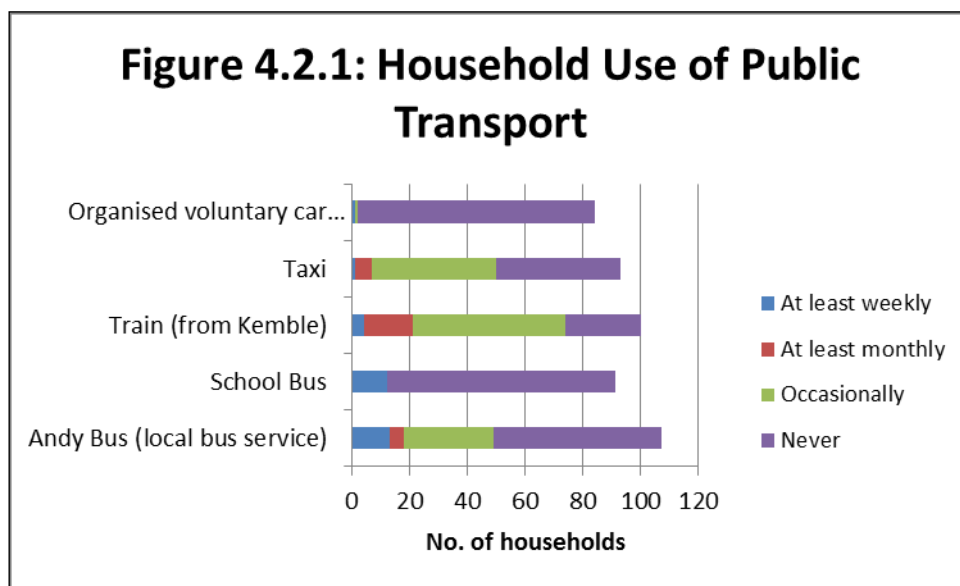


## 4.2 Transport and Traffic

Car ownership in the Parish is high with most households (72%) owning at least two cars. However, 5% of households own no cars. Because of this, the majority of households do not experience any difficulty in accessing services (doctor, hospital etc), shops or friends and family outside of the Parish.

However, 10% of households experience difficulty accessing their doctor or Cirencester hospital. Of these 11 households, 73% have members who are over 60 years old.

There are a number of public transport services available to households and the following chart displays their use.



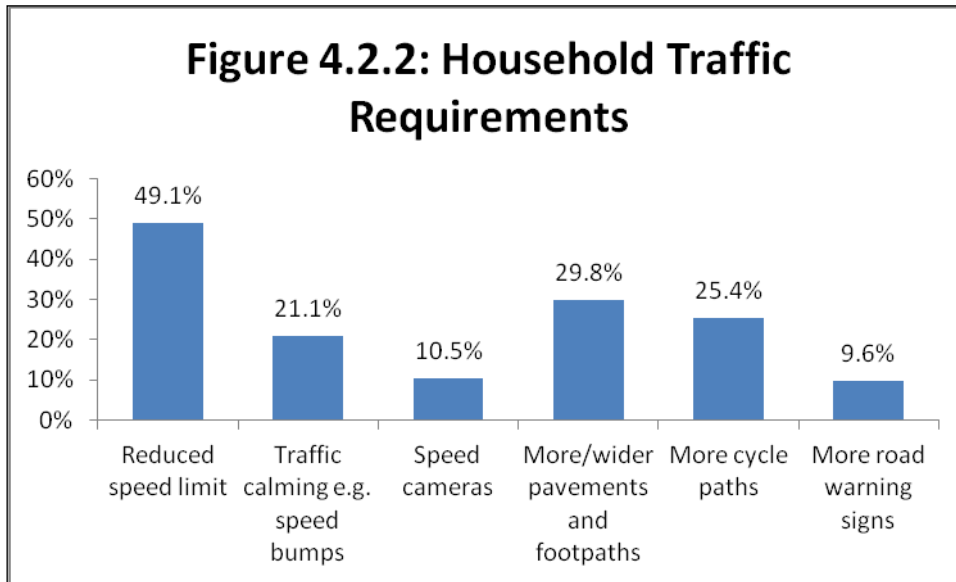
Despite the fact that only a modest number (15%) of households use the Andy Bus (which provides a public transport service to Cirencester and Malmesbury) on a regular basis, over half the number of households (57%) view the service as an essential part of the village's life and a similar number (51%) view it as important for other households.
